## SR. HIGH MISSIONS TRIP INFORMATION SHEET

### LOCATION

Cancun, Mexico

### WHEN?

July 1 – 8, 2010

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any students connected to this ministry **who has completed** 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade this calendar school year 2009-10. Attendance at ER Youth Group, Sunday school or Sunday morning church at Bethel A/G is required for consideration for this trip.

### WHAT WILL WE DO?

Students will spend time working with local churches running a VBS, games, drama, music, teaching, laughing, playing, smiling, caring, and sharing Christ's love. During the afternoon we will be in the barrios of Cancun distributing clothing and food to the poor. We will also participate in bilingual worship services on Sunday. At the end of the trip we have a free day to explore the Isla Mujeres of Mexico.

### WHERE DO WE STAY?

Housing will be at the Oasis America in Cancun. We will eat breakfast at the hotel before we leave for ministry. Lunch will be served at the ministry site by our host group and dinner will be at a local restaurant.

### WHAT IS THE COST?

Individuals: Approximately \$450 plus airfare (currently \$500). Price includes: lodging, food and water, transportation in Cancun, administrative fees and ministry supplies. Other costs will include a passport (\$85-100) which is needed to travel to another country. ### Payment Schedule

1. \$100 deposit due with application.
2. \$300 due February 21<sup>st</sup>
3. \$300 due April 18<sup>th</sup>
4. \$300 due June 20<sup>th</sup>

### WHAT'S NEXT?

1. Pray. Talk to your parents/family. Ask God to show you if He wants you on this trip.
2. Fill out application and reference forms and return with \$100 deposit.
3. Have your parents sign the Parental Approval Letter and Discipline Agreement Form.
4. Pastor Ron and a mission board representative will review all applications and reference forms and will approve students for the trip. All approved team members will have their \$100 deposit applied to their plane ticket. It will then become nonrefundable.
5. Students will discuss fundraising with Pastor Ron.
6. Get your passport. Download an application off the Internet at the following site: [http://travel.state.gov/passport/get/first/first\\_830.html](http://travel.state.gov/passport/get/first/first_830.html). It has directions on how to get a passport. It takes 6-8 weeks to secure a passport; so do it as soon as possible.
7. Attend all training meetings. Beginning in January we will begin monthly Team Meetings that will be required for all Missions Team Members.
