James 5:13a NIV

"Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray."

Psalm 16:1 NIV

**“Keep me safe, O God,
for in you I take refuge.”**

When should we pray?

2. WHEN THINGS ARE GOOD

James 5:13b NIV

"Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise."

Ephesians 5:20 NIV

"always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

When should we pray?

4. WHEN WE FAIL

James 5:16a NIV

"Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed."

James 5:16b NIV

“The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.”

Romans 3:22 NIV

"This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference,"

Great Prayer Example

"Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops."

5. WHEN OTHERS DRIFT FROM FAITH

James 5:19-20 NIV

"My dear brothers and sisters, if anyone among you wanders away from the truth and is brought back again, you can be sure that the one who brings that person back will save that sinner from death and bring about the forgiveness of many sins."

James 5:14-15 NIV
